The Fund seeks to achieve its investment objective by providing a stream of income for investors looking for geographic and currency diversification, and potentially higher returns.

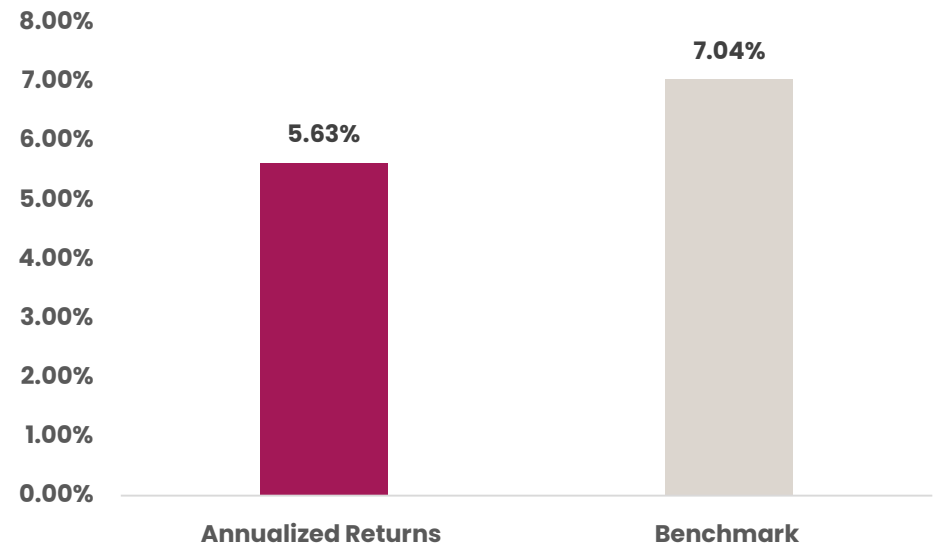

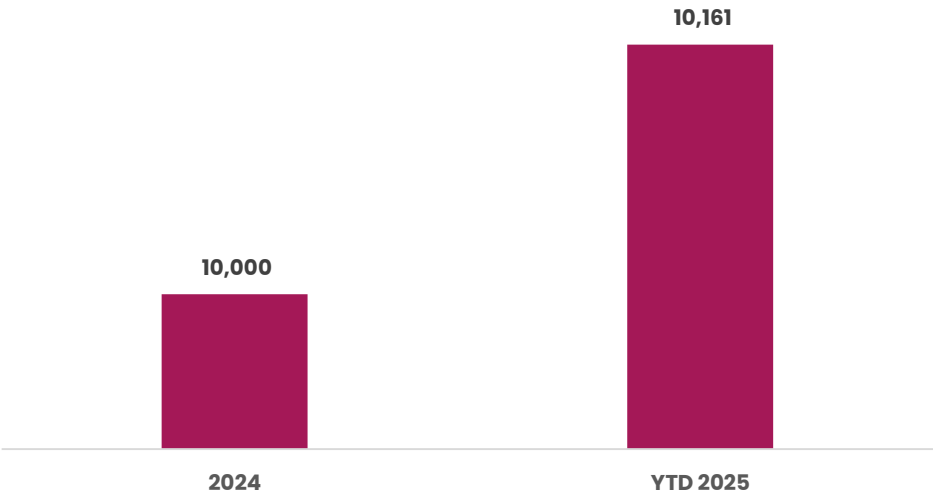

Fund Performance

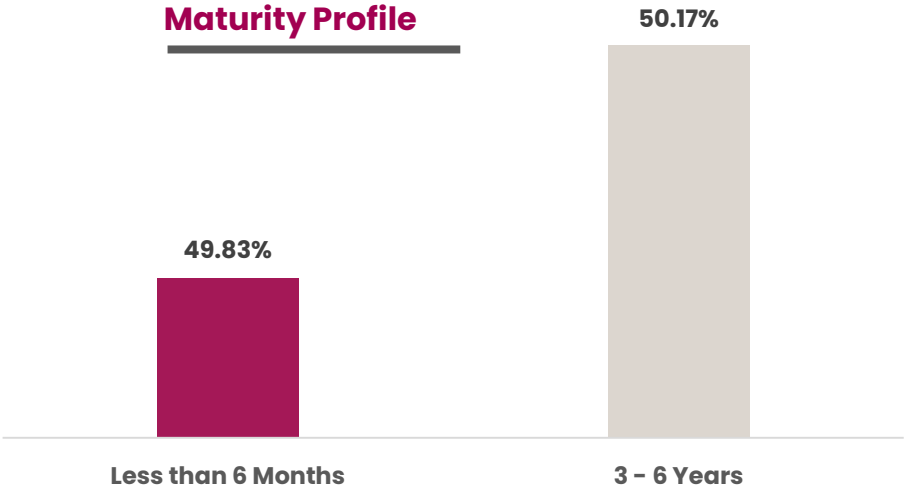


Growth of N10,000 investment since 31/12/24 to Date
